Betr.: Agentur für die Zusammenarbeit der Energieregulierungsbehörden

– Beschluss über die vom Rat zu ernennenden Mitglieder des Verwaltungsrates

1. Die Agentur für die Zusammenarbeit der Energieregulierungsbehörden wurde mit der Verordnung (EG) Nr. 713/2009 des Europäischen Parlaments und des Rates vom 13. Juli 2009 zur Gründung einer Agentur für die Zusammenarbeit der Energieregulierungsbehörden¹ gegründet.
2. Nach Artikel 12 der Verordnung wird ein Verwaltungsrat eingerichtet, der aus neun Mitgliedern und neun Stellvertretern besteht. Fünf Mitglieder und ihre Stellvertreter sind vom Rat zu ernennen.
3. Der Vorsitzende des ACER-Verwaltungsrates hat den Vorsitz mit Schreiben vom 9. August 2013 davon unterrichtet, dass die vierjährige Amtszeit von zwei Mitgliedern (Detlef Dauke, Deutschland, und Phillip Guillard, Frankreich) und deren Stellvertretern (Péter Gordos, Ungarn, und Maya Hristova, Bulgarien) am 22. Dezember 2013 abläuft. Darüber hinaus ist der Vorsitz davon in Kenntnis gesetzt worden, dass William Rickett, Vereinigtes Königreich, von seinem sechsjährigen Mandat als stellvertretendes Mitglied zurückgetreten ist. Der Rat muss für die ausscheidenden Personen nunmehr zwei neue Mitglieder und drei Stellvertreter ernennen.

 - anschließend auf der Grundlage einer vom Vorsitz entsprechend den Präferenzen des AStV aufgestellten Liste die zwei Mitglieder und die drei Stellvertreter zu benennen.
6. Auf der Grundlage des Ergebnisses des unter Nummer 5 erläuterten Verfahrens wird der förmliche Beschluss des Rates über die Ernennung der zwei Mitglieder und der drei Stellvertreter des Verwaltungsrates dem AStV/Rat als I/A-Punkt unterbreitet.
