In document 14182/13 INIT :

On page 5, the third paragraph should read:

[...] the relevant UN Conventions which provide the international legal framework for addressing the illicit drugs phenomena and the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (see annex A).

On page 6, the second paragraph should read:

In this respect it is important to underline the key priorities:

- to achieve a measurable reduction in the demand for drugs and consequent drug abuse- related health and social risks and harms as well as effective countering of the drug trafficking:

On page 6, the second and forth bullet point should read:

- [...] a better understanding of all aspects of the drugs phenomenon and of the impact of interventions in order to provide sound and comprehensive evidence-base for policies and actions ~~and international organisations on drug issues;~~
- [..]
- To further strengthen dialogue and cooperation between the EU and third countries **and international organisations on drug issues.**

On page 8, the second bullet point should read:

[...] (developing processing data mechanisms to draw timely conclusions of and swiftly address new trends, e.g. emergence of new psychoactive substances and misuse of prescribed controlled medications);

On page 10, the forth paragraph should read:

The support of the ~~institution~~ of National Focal Points is a key element for ensuring reliability of data. The support to those institutions is maintained in the current Action Plan.

On page 13, the first paragraph should read:

[...] so as to ensure effective sustained results, in particular concerning criminal **proceeds**, corruption, money laundering;

On page 18, the last sentence should read:

- the European Union Drug Strategy 2013-2020 and the EU Drugs Action Plan for 2013-2016
