Subject: Amendments of the European Parliament to the Council's position on the draft budget for 2014

---

1. During its Plenary session of 23 October 2013, the European Parliament intends to adopt amendments to the Council's position on the draft budget for 2014 as recommended by the European Parliament's Committee on Budgets on 2 and 3 October. At this occasion, the Presidency of the Council should take note of this fact, and consequently agree that the President of the European Parliament convenes the Conciliation Committee as required (Article 314(4)(c) TFEU).

2. On 14 October, the Budget Committee of the Council examined those amendments and unanimously agreed that it could not approve them all. For the purposes of the continuation of the budgetary procedure for 2014, the Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore invited to suggest the Council to:
- confirm that it cannot approve all the amendments to the Council's position on the draft budget for 2014 should they be adopted by the European Parliament;
  - approve the annexed draft letter to the European Parliament to that effect.
