Subject:	Amendments of the European Parliament to the Council's position on the draft budget for 2014

1. During its Plenary session of 23 October 2013, the <u>European Parliament</u> intends to adopt amendments to the Council's position on the draft budget for 2014 as recommended by the European Parliament's Committee on Budgets on 2 and 3 October. At this occasion, the Presidency of the Council should take note of this fact, and consequently agree that the President of the European Parliament convenes the Conciliation Committee as required (Article 314(4)(c) TFEU).
