Dear Ms Cann,

We have registered your request of 7 October 2013. Thank you for your interest.

The General Secretariat of the Council has examined your request on the basis of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 of the European Parliament and of the Council regarding public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents¹ (hereafter the "Regulation") and specific provisions of the Council's Rules of Procedure² and has come to the following conclusion:

The documents held by the GSC related to the information you have requested contain personal data. Disclosure of the information contained therein would undermine the protection of privacy and the integrity of the individual in question, in particular in accordance with European Union legislation regarding the protection of personal data. Accordingly, pursuant to Article 4(1)(b) of the Regulation (protection of privacy and the integrity of the individual), the General Secretariat is unable to accede to your request.

Statutory remedy notice

Pursuant to Article 7(2) of the Regulation, you may submit a confirmatory application requesting the Council to reconsider this position, within 15 working days of receiving this reply³.

Dear European Council,

Please pass this on to the person who conducts Freedom of Information reviews.

I am writing to request an internal review of European Council's handling of my FOI request 'Gayle Kimberley and personal leave'.

I was very surprised by your letter which refused to provide the imformation I had requested. My initial request was very clear and simple in that I only asked for confirmation of whether a particular individual remains on the staff of the European Council or not. I did not request any personal details relating to that individual. If it makes it easier, I would be happy to receive an email containing the requested information, rather than specific documents themselves.

I note that other EU institutions have an online staff directory which makes it possible to search for individual staff members. The Council does not appear to have such a facility which reduces its claim to be transparent.
