The Council agreed on the general approach, as set out in doc. 7377/10 EF 22 ECOFIN 154 CODEC 189, and invited the Presidency to start negotiations with the European Parliament on the basis of this general approach with a view to reaching an agreement in first reading. The Council also agreed to enter into its minutes the following statement:

### **Statement by the Council**

"The Council notes the concerns expressed by some Member States on certain aspects of the Presidency's proposed general approach, in particular as regards to the third country provisions.

It invites the Presidency to start negotiations with the European Parliament on the basis of this general approach, taking into account the concerns expressed by Member States."

The Council took note of the presentation by the Commission of its draft budget for 2011. It instructed the Permanent Representatives Committee to prepare Council's position on the draft budget, scheduled for July 2010.
