At its meeting on 14 June 2010, <u>the General Affairs Council</u> agreed on a general approach, on a draft Regulation on the European Citizens' Initiative.

Statement by France, the Czech Republic, Italy and Lithuania:

"France, the Czech Republic, Italy and Lithuania accept the Presidency's proposal as a general approach, with a view to the forthcoming discussions with the European Parliament. It notes that this is just a starting point for the adoption by the Council and the Parliament of the proposal for a Regulation on the citizens' initiative.

France recalls that is has always expressed its preference that the check on the admissibility of a citizens' initiative should take place when it is registered rather than at a later stage.

It emphasises that this possibility must be examined in depth, if it is addressed in the context of the forthcoming dialogue between the Council and the European Parliament."
