Subject:	Conclusion of the written procedure for the adoption of a Council Implementing Regulation amending Regulation (EC) No 1292/2007 imposing a definitive anti-dumping duty on imports of polyethylene terephthalate (PET) film originating in India

On 9 December 2011, the Commission submitted the above-mentioned proposal to the Council, which was requested to take a decision on it as soon as possible (18562/11 ANTIDUMPING 109 COMER 259 OC 86).

Pursuant to Article 12 of the Council's Rules of Procedure¹, a written procedure for its adoption was launched on 13 December 2011 (CM 5891/11 + REV 1). This written procedure was completed on Friday, 6 January 2012 (noon).

The Commission and all delegations agreed to the use of the written procedure. All delegations voted in favour of the proposal.

Consequently, the Council adopted the Implementing Regulation, as set out after legal and linguistic editing in doc. 18563/11 ANTIDUMPING 110 COMER 260 OC 87, which will be published in the Official Journal on 12 January 2012 and enter into force the following day.
