Subject: **Anti-dumping**

Proposal for a Council Regulation imposing a definitive anti-dumping duty on imports of steel ropes and cables originating in the People's Republic of China and Ukraine as extended to imports of steel ropes and cables consigned from Morocco, Moldova and the Republic of Korea, whether declared as originating in these countries or not, following an expiry review pursuant to Article 11(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1225/2009 and terminating the expiry review proceeding concerning imports of steel ropes and cables originating in South Africa pursuant to Article 11(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1225/2009

Delegations are requested to examine the above Commission proposal, circulated on 10 January 2012 as document 5204/12 ANTIDUMPING 1 COMER 5, on which the Council should act as soon as possible.

If no comments have been received by the General Secretariat of the Council (e-mailed to [secretariat.polcom@consilium.europa.eu](mailto:secretariat.polcom@consilium.europa.eu) or faxed to 02/281.73.74) before **Wednesday, 18 January 2012 (noon)**, the proposal will be submitted for approval to the Permanent Representatives Committee (Part 2, meeting on 25 January 2012, as "I" item), with a view to its adoption as "A" item by the Council at its meeting on 27 January 2012. Publication in the Official Journal is scheduled for 9 February 2012.
