Subject:	Multiannual Financial Framework (2014-2020)
	- Questionnaire on the main priorities and the budgetary framework, including the
	overall amounts

On 29 June 2011, the Commission submitted a communication accompanied by legislative proposals relating to the Multiannual Financial Framework (MFF) 2014-2020 as well as to the Own Resources system of the European Union. During the second semester 2011, the Council carried out intensive preparatory work on the future financial framework, covering all areas of expenditure as well as the resources side. The Polish Presidency summarised the outcome of this work in a report it submitted in December (doc. 17448/1/11).

Following this clarification phase, discussions at Council level should serve to narrow gaps between delegations' positions on the key issues and, where possible, reconcile them, in order to meet the ambitious mandate given to the Presidency by the European Council on 9 December 2011.

In order to further consolidate the approach to the overall MFF package and lay the grounds for further detailed discussions during this semester, the Presidency proposes to focus the General Affairs Council on 27 January 2012 on the <u>main priorities</u> and the <u>budgetary framework</u>, including the <u>overall amounts</u>.

- 1. Based on the Commission proposal, the Presidency wishes to draw the overall picture of where the main challenges for the negotiations lie and where convergence of views may be found within the global package.
 - What are delegations' main priorities within the overall package relating to the 2014-2020 MFF?
- 2. Based on the Commission proposal, the Presidency wishes to have better knowledge of positions both as regards the overall figures and as regards the specific figures per heading as well as for expenditure which the Commission proposes to put outside the MFF.
 - Do delegations agree with the overall amounts proposed by the Commission for the 2014-2020 MFF? If not, what level would they find appropriate? What consequences would that have for individual headings and expenditure proposed to be outside the MFF?
