Subject: Proposal for a Council Decision on the adoption of a Supplementary Research
Programme for the ITER project (2014-2018)

- Optional consultation of the European Parliament and the European Economic and Social Committee¹

- 1. On 21 December 2011 the <u>Commission</u> submitted to the <u>Council</u> the Proposal for a Council Decision on the adoption of a Supplementary Research Programme for the ITER project (2014-2018)².
- 2. The purpose of the Proposal is to define the funding arrangement for the EU contribution to the ITER project for the period of 2014-2018 through a Supplementary Research Programme under the Euratom Treaty.

- 3. The legal basis for the Supplementary Research Programme is provided for in Article 7 of the Euratom Treaty. This Article provides for the Council to act unanimously on a proposal from the Commission. Thus, the Opinions of the European Parliament and of the European Economic and Social Committee are not required. However, it may be recalled that the European Parliament and the European Economic and Social Committee were consulted on the proposals concerning the Seventh Euratom Framework Programme as well as on the proposals providing for its continuation, into which the funding of the ITER project was previously integrated. For the sake of consistency it therefore appears appropriate to consult the European Parliament and the Economic and Social Committee on the present Proposal.
- 4. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore invited to decide, in accordance with Article 19(7)(h) of the Council's Rules of Procedure, to consult the <u>European Parliament</u> and the <u>Economic and Social Committee</u> on the above Proposal and to request them to give their opinions as soon as possible.
