Subject: Proposal for a Council Decision on the position of the European Union in relation to the draft Regulation of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe concerning Pedestrian Safety and to the draft Regulation of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe concerning Light Emitting Diode (LED) light sources together with its corrigenda
- Adoption

1. On 14 July 2011, the Commission submitted to the Council the above proposal, which aims at defining the position of European Union in relation to the draft Regulation of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe concerning Pedestrian Safety and to the draft Regulation of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe concerning Light Emitting Diode (LED) light sources together with its corrigenda. The legal basis of the proposal requires the consent of the European Parliament.
2. The proposal was presented to the Technical Harmonisation Working Party on 19 July 2011. Following the written procedure, the Working Party approved this proposal.

3. On 29 September 2011, the Council decided on the transmission of the draft decision to the European Parliament in order to obtain its consent.
4. The European Parliament consented to the draft Council Decision on 19 January 2012.
5. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore invited to suggest to the Council to decide, in part "A" of the agenda of a forthcoming meeting, to adopt the draft decision as contained in document 13895/11 ECO 106 ENT 182 MI 408 (text finalised by the legal/linguistic experts).
