At its meeting on 18 January 2012, the <u>Working Party on Financial Agricultural Questions</u> (<u>AGRIFIN</u>) examined Special Report No 12/2011 from the European Court of Auditors entitled "Have EU measures contributed to adapting the capacity of the fishing fleets to available fishing opportunities?" (doc. 18631/11).
- 2. At its meeting on 13 February 2012, the <u>Working Party on Financial Agricultural Questions</u>
 (AGRIFIN) reached agreement on draft Council conclusions on the above report.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION

- (1) WELCOMES Special Report No 12/2011 from the European Court of Auditors, entitled "Have EU measures contributed to adapting the capacity of the fishing fleets to available fishing opportunities?";
- (2) NOTES that the audit was carried out at the Commission and in seven Member States;
- (3) RECALLS that on 13 July 2011, the Commission adopted a proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on the Common Fisheries Policy¹ and that on 2 December 2011, the Commission adopted a proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on the European Fisheries Fund². Both proposals are currently being examined in Council and by the Council's preparatory bodies and the Special Report in question has also been referred to in the context of this examination.
