Corrections of the maps contained in Annex I and III to Commission proposal COM(2011)650

The document lists the obvious errors contained in the maps of Annex I and III of the Commission proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on Union guidelines for the development of the trans-European transport network (COM(2011)650).

There are five types of corrections:

- for a very limited number of the almost 10.000 sections contained in the maps, the status of the infrastructure (completed/to be upgraded/planned, high speed or conventional rail) has not been correctly reflected as discussed with the Member States concerned;
- 2. certain very small gaps appear in the core network which should by principle not be interrupted; these gaps are due to clerical mistakes in the database;
- 3. some names are missing for certain ports, while the Turkish names for Cypriot cities should not appear;
- 4. certain ports, airports or rail road terminals have been included on the maps although they do not reach the respective thresholds set out in Chapter II of the proposal and need to be removed, while others have to be included; consistency with the list of core infrastructure of Annex II has to be ensured;
- 5. the indicative maps for third countries need to be aligned to the agreements accepted by the Commission in the accession negotiations.
