I hereby notify you that, in accordance with Article 3(1) of the above mentioned Protocol, Ireland wishes to take part in the adoption and application of the following proposal:

Proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council on criminal sanctions for insider dealing and market manipulation.
