Declaration by the High Representative on behalf of the European Union on the alignment of certain third countries with the Council Decision 2012/50/CFSP amending Decision 2011/72/CFSP concerning restrictive measures directed against certain persons and entities in view of the situation in Tunisia

On 27 January 2012, the Council adopted Council Decision 2012/50/CFSP¹. The Council Decision extends the restrictive measures directed against certain persons and entities in view of the situation in Tunisia until 31 January 2013.

The Acceding Country Croatia*, the Candidate Countries the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia*, Montenegro* and Iceland⁺, the Countries of the Stabilisation and Association Process and potential candidates Albania and Serbia, and the EFTA countries Liechtenstein and Norway, members of the European Economic Area, as well as the Republic of Moldova and Armenia align themselves with this decision.

They will ensure that their national policies conform to this Council Decision.

The European Union takes note of this commitment and welcomes it.
