- Case T-58/12 Ghasem NABIPOUR a.o. v. Council

1. By application notified to the Council on 20 February 2012, Ghasem NABIPOUR a.o. have brought an action pursuant to Articles 263 for the annulment of Council Decision 2011/783/CFSP of 1 December 2011 and Council Implementing Regulation (EU) No 1245/2011 of 1 December 2011 in so far as they concern the Applicant.
2. The Applicant relies upon the following grounds in support of his claim:
  - the reasons given by the Council are inadequate and insufficient;
  - manifest error of assessment and lack of legal basis in listing the Applicants;
  - breach of the Applicants' rights of defence and the right to effective judicial review ;
  - breach of the Applicants' fundamental rights, including their right to protection of their property, business, reputation and private and family life.
3. The Director-General of the Council Legal Service has appointed Ms. Melpo-Menie JOSÉPHIDÈS and Mr. Augustin VARNAV, members of the Legal Service, as the Council's agents in Case T-58/12.
