	- Optional consultation of the European Economic and Social Committee and the Committee of Regions <sup>1</sup>

- By letter of 12 March 2012, the Commission presented the above mentioned proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council on the freezing and confiscation of proceeds of crime in the European Union.
- 2. The text of the proposal is set out in 7641/12 DROIPEN 29 COPEN 57 CODEC 656.
- 3. The proposal is based on Articles 82(2) and 83(1) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union (TFEU).

- 4. In the accompanying letter to the proposal the Commission suggests to the Council to consult the European Economic and Social Committee and the Committee of Regions. The procedure is in accordance with Articles 304 and 307 TFEU respectively and Article 19(7)(h) of the Council's Rules of Procedure.
- 5. In view of the above, COREPER is invited to:
  - request the European Economic and Social Committee and the Committee of Regions to deliver their opinion on the Commission proposal set out in 7641/12 DROIPEN 29 COPEN 57 CODEC 656 as soon as possible and at the latest by November 2012.
