#### 1. Illegal migration

### Orientation by the Commission and Frontex

Frontex and the EEAS made presentations on recent developments and the Presidency reported on the work underway on the development of the Roadmap in relation to the EU response to increased migration pressure. The Presidency welcomed the contribution made to that work by seven Member States (AT, BE, FR, DE, NL, SE, UK). The Presidency also indicated that in the coming weeks the Roadmap would be discussed in a number of working parties with a view to returning to the issue in the April 2012 JHA Council.

# 2. The situation in Greece in relation to Schengen - Orientation by the Commission, EASO and Frontex

The Committee had an exchange of views on this item and recognised that there is scope for reinforcing practical assistance to Greece in the area of return. The Committee invited the relevant preparatory bodies to follow-up on its discussion with a view to Ministers returning to the issue at a future meeting.
