 The Commission submitted to the Council a proposal for transfer of appropriations No. DEC08/2012 within Section III - Commission - of the general budget for 2012.

The purpose of this proposal is to release the reserves of EUR 5.5 million from Article 40 02 41 (*Reserves for financial interventions - differentiated appropriations*) to Article 16 02 02 (*Multimedia actions*) and item 16 03 02 01 (*Communication of the Commission Representations*), as recorded in document 9253/12 FIN 291.

2. The aim of this transfer is to release the reserve of EUR 5.5 million, the Commission having fulfilled the conditions for releasing these reserves.

- 3. <u>The Budget Committee</u> examined the proposal for a transfer at its meeting on 8 May 2012.
- 4. Following that examination, <u>the Budget Committee</u> agreed, by qualified majority, to suggest that the Permanent Representatives Committee advise the Council to approve:
 - the proposed transfer of appropriations;
 - the draft letter in ANNEX to that effect.
