Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1612/68 of 15 October 1968 on freedom of movement for workers within the Community<sup>1</sup>, and in particular Articles 26 and 27 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) In its Decisions of 21 October 2010<sup>2</sup> and 21 March 2011<sup>3</sup>, the Council appointed the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers for the period ending on 24 September 2012.
- (2) A seat as member in the trade union representatives category has fallen vacant as a result of the resignation of Ms Zanda GRUNDBERGA.
