3. **Quality Package**

(a) <u>Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council amending</u> <u>Council Regulation (EC) No 1234/2007 as regards marketing standards</u>

Preparation for the second informal trilogue

The <u>SCA</u> took note of the <u>broad support</u> for the revised Presidency compromise text (doc 6544/1/12 REV 1) while noting the <u>absence of a qualified majority</u> on the open issues identified in document 6544/1/12 REV 1. The <u>SCA</u> also took note of the <u>Commission</u> position.

Given the absence of a complete mandate to continue negotiations with the European Parliament at this stage, the <u>Presidency</u> indicated its intention to inform the Rapporteur and to reflect on the adjustments to be made to the Council text on the Single CMO CAP Reform draft Regulation.

(b) <u>Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on</u> <u>Agricultural Product Quality Schemes</u>

Analysis of the final compromise text 8329/12 AGRI 196 AGRIORG 57 AGRILEG 49 CODEC 874

The <u>SCA</u> examined the last Presidency proposal for Article 42 on the major question of management of supply (Annex II to 8329/12 and modifications introduced by the Presidency Flash circulated prior to the SCA meeting on 16 April 2012). A qualified majority could not be gathered on this proposal.

The <u>SCA</u> accepted to extend to 10 years the transitional period for the traditional specialities guaranteed without reservation of the name (Article 25.2).

4. <u>Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council amending</u> <u>Council Regulation (EC) No 834/2007 on organic production and labelling of organic</u> <u>products</u>

<u>The Presidency</u> submitted a revised Presidency compromise text in order to get a renewed mandate to continue negotiations with the European Parliament at the forthcoming third trilogue. The Commission welcomed the new amendments proposed by the Presidency.

Although delegations were generally in favour of the new Presidency compromise text, some questions were raised, especially in relation to article Article 27. In the light of these comments, to be provided to the Presidency in writing, a revised draft will be circulated to the delegations, before the next trilogue.

<u>The SCA</u> took note of the Commission's introduction, of delegations' views and of the Commission's reply. The Presidency called upon delegations to demonstrate the greatest degree of flexibility as regards sharing, both with the Council and with the European Parliament, the results of the calculations of the new delimitation of the areas, other than mountain areas, facing significant natural constraints.
