DECLARATION BY GERMANY AND FINLAND

"Despite some concerns Germany and Finland do not intend to raise objections against the Delegated Regulation and, hence, given the time constraints, consent to the request of the Commission for the Council to confirm that it will not to raise any objections before the expiry of the three months period on 30 June 2012."

DECLARATON BY GERMANY, FINLAND, AUSTRIA, SWEDEN, AND THE NETHERLANDS

"It must be kept in mind that an early approval of delegated acts is considered an exception from the normal procedure and that the participation rights of the Council and the European Parliament with respect to delegated acts must not be undermined by late adoption and notification of the delegated acts by the Commission."
