Subject :	Proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC13/2012 within Section III - Commission - of the general budget for 2012

 The Commission submitted to the Council a proposal for a transfer of appropriations No DEC13/2012 within Section III - Commission - of the general budget for 2012.

The purpose of this proposal is to reinforce Article 23 02 02 (*Food aid*) with EUR 40 million in commitment appropriations from Article 40 02 42 (*Emergency aid reserve*), as recorded in document 10678/12 FIN 380.

- 2. The transfer is being proposed in order to reinforce the humanitarian aid chapter for an amount of EUR 40 million in order to answer to the deepening food crisis in the Sahel region.
- 3. The Budget Committee examined the proposal for a transfer at its meeting on 5 June 2012.
- 4. In accordance with the provisions of Point 25 of the Interinstitutional Agreement of 17 May 2006, a simplified trilogue was held on the Commission proposal.

- 5. Following that examination, the Budget Committee agreed, by a qualified majority, to suggest that the Permanent Representatives Committee advise the Council to approve:
  - the proposed transfer of appropriations;
  - the draft letter in ANNEX to that effect.
