Work programme of the incoming Presidency

The Energy Council will be informed on the priorities of the incoming Cyprus Presidency and the main events in the energy field scheduled during the second semester of 2012.

Based on the orientations set by the European Council, the Cyprus Presidency will focus its work on the legislative proposals for Energy Infrastructure and for the Safety of Offshore Oil and Gas related activities, as well as on the communication on Renewable Energy. Another important issue to be addressed will be the internal energy market.

The priorities set by the Cyprus Presidency will be reflected in the agendas of the Informal Meeting of the Energy Ministers on 17 September in Nicosia and the formal TTE (Energy) Council on 3 December in Brussels.
