Subject:	COUNCIL REGULATION amending Regulation (EC) No 975/98 on
5	denominations and technical specifications of euro coins intended for circulation

- On 25 May 2011 the Council received a Commission proposal for a Council Regulation amending Regulation (EC) No 975/98 on denominations and technical specifications of euro coins intended for circulation.
- 2. The Economic and Financial Committee examined the proposal and suggested certain amendments to the text.
- 3. In accordance with the provisions of article 128(2) of the TFEU, the European Parliament and the European Central Bank have been consulted on the proposal.
- 4. On 16 February 2012 Coreper endorsed the text as agreed in the EFC, subject to legal and linguistic revision.
- 5. Delegation of Slovenia informed the Council Secretariat of its intention to oppose to the proposal. The Permanent Representatives Committee is then invited to adopt at a forthcoming meeting the above-mentioned acts as set out in document 8942/12 by qualify majority voting rule (pursuant to the provisions of Article 16(3) TEU).
