Subject :	<b>Anti-dumping</b> Proposal for a Council Implementing Regulation amending Council Implementing Regulation (EU) No 917/2011 imposing a definitive anti-dumping duty and collecting definitively the provisional duty imposed on imports of ceramic tiles originating in the People's Republic of China, by adding a company to the list of producers from the People's Republic of China listed in Annex I

1. On 29 May 2012, the Commission submitted the above proposal for an Implementing Regulation to the Council, which is requested to take a decision on it as soon as possible.
2. Delegations were consulted (see CM 3237/12) and all agreed with the proposal.
3. The Permanent Representatives Committee (Part 2, meeting on 20 June) is therefore invited to recommend that, as an "A" item on the agenda for its meeting on 25 June 2012, the Council adopt the Implementing Regulation as finalised by the Legal/Linguistic experts and set out in document 10523/12 ANTIDUMPING 37 COMER 120.
4. Once adopted, the Implementing Regulation will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union on 29 June 2012 and enter into force the following day.
