Subject: Anti-dumping

Proposal for a Council Implementing Regulation amending the Implementing Regulation of the Council (EU) No 102/2012 imposing a definitive anti-dumping duty on imports of steel ropes and cables originating, inter alia, in the People's Republic of China as extended to imports of steel ropes and cables consigned from, inter alia, the Republic of Korea, whether declared as originating in the Republic of Korea or not

- 1. On 29 May 2012, the Commission submitted the above proposal for an Implementing Regulation to the Council, which is requested to take a decision on it as soon as possible.
- 2. Delegations were consulted (see CM 3236/12) and all agreed with the proposal.
- 3. The Permanent Representatives Committee (Part 2, meeting on 20 June) is therefore invited to recommend that, as an "A" item on the agenda for its meeting on 25 June 2012, the Council adopt the Implementing Regulation as finalised by the Legal/Linguistic experts and set out in document 10520/12 ANTIDUMPING 34 COMER 117.
- 4. Once adopted, the Implementing Regulation will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union on 28 June 2012 and enter into force the following day.
