Subject:	Draft COMMISSION DECISION of XXX amending Decision 2000/96/EC as regards tick-borne encephalitis and the category of vector-borne communicable diseases
	– Decision not to oppose adoption

1. Article 3(a) of Decision No 2119/98/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 24 September 1998 setting up a network for the epidemiological surveillance and control of communicable diseases in the Community¹, stipulates that the communicable diseases to be progressively covered by the Community network shall be determined in accordance with the regulatory procedure with scrutiny.

- 2. Therefore, before adopting the above mentioned measures and in accordance with Article 5a(2) of Council Decision 1999/468/EC², the Commission consulted the Regulatory Committee set up by Decision No 2119/98/EC on 27 April 2012, which voted by unanimity in favour of the above draft Decision.
- 3. Consequently, the Commission submitted the above draft Decision to the Council on 14 May 2012, in accordance with Article 5a(3)(a) of Council Decision 1999/468/EC.
- Under the regulatory procedure with scrutiny, the Council, acting by qualified majority, may 4 oppose the Commission's adoption of the draft Commission Decision on the grounds that the draft measures presented by the Commission:
 - exceed the implementing powers provided for in the basic instrument, or
 - are not compatible with the aim or the content of the basic instrument, or
 - do not respect the principles of subsidiarity or proportionality.
- 5. The delegations were asked on 31 May 2012 to indicate until 18 June 2012 their possible opposition to the draft Decision. The delegations did not raise any of the above-mentioned grounds for opposition.
- 6. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore invited to recommend to the Council to confirm, as an "A" item of its agenda, that it is not opposed to the draft **Decision in subject.** Unless the European Parliament opposes the Decision within 3 months from its submission, the Commission may adopt it in accordance with the procedure under Article 5a(3)(d) of Council Decision 1999/468/EC.
