Subject: **Anti-dumping**

Proposal for a Council Implementing Regulation extending the definitive anti-dumping duty imposed by Council Implementing Regulation (EU) No 791/2011 on imports of certain open mesh fabrics of glass fibres originating in the People's Republic of China to imports of certain open mesh fabrics of glass fibres consigned from Malaysia, whether declared as originating in Malaysia or not

Delegations are requested to examine the above Commission proposal, circulated on 21 June 2012 as document 11740/12 ANTIDUMPING 56 COMER 157, on which the Council should act as soon as possible.
