2. **Common European Asylum System [First Reading]**

State of play 8595/12 ASILE 62 CODEC 938

The Council took note, on the basis of the state of play as set out on doc. 8595/12 regarding various legislative proposals concerning the Common European Asylum System (CEAS).

In keeping with the commitment to establish a CEAS by the end of 2012, the Council instructed its preparatory bodies to continue work on the different proposals.

Notwithstanding a number of concerns raised by some delegations, the Council reached a general approach and accepted that the Presidency would start formal negotiations with the EP on the basis of the text set out in doc. 8916/12.

The Council

- held an orientation debate based on the Presidency compromise outlined in doc. 8922/12.
- decided to mandate the Presidency to seek an agreement at first reading with the European Parliament based on the mandate given during the Polish Presidency (set out in doc. 16493/11) with the changes explained in doc. 8922/12.

After a presentation by the Commission and an exchange of views, the <u>Presidency</u> concluded that work would continue in the preparatory bodies of the Council.

The Council endorsed the partial general approach and noted broad support for Articles 5-12 and the corresponding recitals, subject to scrutiny reservations of certain delegations on recital 18. The Council acknowledged that at a later stage of negotiations it might be necessary to revert to Articles 5-12 once Articles 1-4 have been agreed on.

14. Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on mutual recognition of protection measures in civil matters [First Reading]

The Council

- a) endorsed the guidelines proposed by the Presidency which shall provide guidance for the future work on the proposed Regulation, and
- b) confirmed that the examination of the proposal in the preparatory bodies of the Council should be continued as a matter of priority.
