Subject:	Legal acts in the excessive deficit procedure: Adoption of linguistic versions not available at the time of adoption of acts by the Council: - Council Decision abrogating Decision 2010/422/EU on the existence of an excessive deficit in Bulgaria - Council Decision abrogating Decision 2010/285/EU on the existence of an excessive deficit in Germany

1. On 22 June 2012, the Council adopted an incomplete set of language versions of two Decisions under Article 126(12) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, abrogating Decision 2010/422/EU on the existence of an excessive deficit in Bulgaria and abrogating Decision 2010/285/EU on the existence of an excessive deficit in Germany.
2. The above-mentioned legal acts were adopted in an incomplete set of language versions on the grounds of urgency. The texts of these legal acts have since been finalised by the jurist-linguists in all other official languages of the EU.
3. COREPER could therefore suggest that the Council adopt at a forthcoming meeting all the relevant language versions of the above-mentioned acts as set out in documents 11080/12 ECOFIN 557 UEM 195 and 11079/12 ECOFIN 556 UEM 194.
