Subject:	Written procedure for the adoption of the proposal for a Council Implementing Regulation amending Implementing Regulation (EU) No 723/2011 (extending the definitive anti-dumping duty imposed by Council Regulation (EC) No 91/2009 on imports of certain iron or steel fasteners originating in the People's Republic of China to imports of certain iron or steel fasteners consigned from Malaysia, whether declared as originating in Malaysia or not), by granting an exemption from those measures to one Malaysian exporting producer and terminating the registration of imports from that exporting producer

On 28 June 2012, the Commission submitted the above proposal (doc. 12041/12 ANTIDUMPING 59 COMER 164). This Regulation should be published in the Official Journal on 31 July 2012 at the latest.

In view of the urgency of the matter, the Presidency has proposed using a written procedure pursuant to Article 12 of the Council's Rules of Procedure<sup>1</sup>.
