Declaration by the High Representative on behalf of the European Union on the alignment of certain third countries with Council Decision 2012/333/CFSP updating the list of persons groups and entities subject to Articles 2,3 and 4 of Common Position 2001/931/CFSP on the application of specific measures to combat terrorism and repealing Decision 2011/872/CFSP

On 25 June 2012, the Council adopted Council Decision 2012/333/CFSP¹. The Council Decision consists of an update of the list of persons, groups and entities subject to the measures provided for in Common Position 2001/931/CFSP on the application of specific measures to combat terrorism.

The Acceding Country Croatia*, the Candidate Countries Montenegro* and Serbia*, the Countries of the Stabilisation and Association Process and potential candidates Albania and Bosnia and Herzegovina, and the EFTA country Liechtenstein, member of the European Economic Area, as well as Ukraine, the Republic of Moldova, and Georgia align themselves with the decision.

They will ensure that their national policies conform to this Council Decision.

The European Union takes note of this commitment and welcomes it.
