As explained in the meeting of the Working Party for Schengen Matters (SIS-TECH) on 11 July, it was recently discovered that in the SIS II project a number of technical actions had to be undertaken for the connection of the SIS II converter to the Member States' systems, the execution of which was considered urgent by different parties. The working party therefore asked that meetings be organised in order to discuss all outstanding issues in relation to the SIS II migration. As a result of an informal meeting held on 16 July, document 12705/12 SIS-TECH 72 COMIX 453 was drawn up.

In the meeting of the Working Party for Schengen Matters (SIS/SIRENE) on 18 July, the group was informed of the budgetary expenses in Annex 4 and proposed to approve the document in silent procedure ending 20 July and under the condition of an agreement by the Working Party for
