On page 5 of document ST 12664/1/12 REV 1, paragraph 13 and paragraph 14 should read as follows:

13. It is understood that the Commission (as regards both cases) and the European Parliament (as regards Case T-396/09 only) will lodge appeals. The Legal Service therefore recommends that appeals be lodged against the judgments in both cases. As the time-limit for doing so expires on **24 August 2012**, and subject to any contrary decision **the Council** might make regarding the bringing of the appeals, the Director-General of the Legal Service has appointed Kristien MICHOEL and Matthew MOORE as agents to represent the Council.

14. In the light of the above, Coreper is invited:
- to recommend to the Council that **it** approve the lodging of an appeal by the Council to the Court of Justice against the judgments of the General Court in Cases T-338/08 and T-396/09;
  - to decide to use the written procedure for adopting that decision.
