Subject: Written procedure for the adoption of the proposal for a Council Implementing Regulation amending Regulation (EU) No 585/2012 imposing a definitive anti-dumping duty on imports of certain seamless pipes and tubes, of iron or steel, originating in Russia and Ukraine, following a partial interim review pursuant to Article 11(3) of Regulation (EC) No 1225/2009

On 30 July 2012, the Commission submitted the above proposal (doc. 13010/12 ANTIDUMPING 62 COMER 176). This Regulation should be published in the Official Journal on 4 September 2012 at the latest.

In view of the urgency of the matter, the Presidency has proposed using a written procedure pursuant to Article 12 of the Council's Rules of Procedure¹.
