The Council approved the amendment set out in the European Parliament's position at first reading and adopted the proposed act amended accordingly, with the Bulgarian and Czech delegations voting against, pursuant to Article 294(4) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union. (Legal basis: Article 114 of the TFEU).

Joint declaration by the Commission, Ireland, Latvia, Lithuania and the United Kingdom concerning the Better Regulation principles

"In a spirit of compromise and in order to allow for an adoption of the Regulation in first reading, the Commission, Ireland, Latvia, Lithuania and the United Kingdom can accept the compromise text although it contains some elements departing from the Commission's proposal.

In particular, the Commission, Ireland, Latvia, Lithuania and the United Kingdom regret that by including already now restrictions for Consumer Automatic Dishwasher Detergents the principles of Better Regulation and evidence-based policy making have not been followed."
