Subject:	Renewal of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers

- The term of office of the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers will expire on 24 September 2012.
- Pursuant to Articles 26 and 27 of Council Regulation (EEC) No 1612/68 of 15 October 1968, members and alternate members are appointed by the Council for a period of two years.
- Lists of nominations of full and alternate members of the renewed Advisory Committee have been received by the Council Secretariat, as set out in the draft Council Decision in doc. 13279/12<sup>1</sup>.
