Subject:	Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No/ of 12.7.2012 supplementing Directive 2010/30/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to energy labelling of electrical lamps and luminaires - Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

<u>The Commission</u> has submitted the above delegated act¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and with Article 10 of Directive 2010/30/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council on the indication by labelling and standard product information of the consumption of energy and other resources by energy-related products ². The Commission having notified the delegated act with regard to energy labelling of of electrical lamps and luminaires on 13 July 2012, <u>the Council</u> may object to it until 13 September 2012.

- 2. <u>The Working Party on Energy</u> has examined the delegated act and agreed that there are no grounds for the Council to object to it.
- 3. It is therefore suggested that <u>Coreper</u> recommend that <u>the Council</u> confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless <u>the European Parliament</u> objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 13 of Directive 2010/30/EU.
