Subject :	Proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 23/2012 within Section III - Commission - of the general budget for 2012

1. On 31 August 2012, the Commission submitted to the Council proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 23/2012.

The purpose of the proposal is to transfer an amount of EUR 4 000 000 in commitment appropriations from Article 15 02 03 (*Cooperation with third countries on education and vocational training*) to Article 19 05 01 (*Cooperation with industrialised third countries*), as recorded in document 13268/12 FIN 616.

2. The transfer is being proposed to allow the additional financing of bilateral projects and Erasmus Mundus Action II projects with industrialised third countries within the framework of the Industrialised Countries Instrument.

- The <u>Budget Committee</u> examined this proposal for a transfer at its meeting on 4 September 2012.
- 4. Following that examination, the <u>Budget Committee</u> agreed, by a qualified majority, to suggest that the Permanent Representatives Committee advise the Council to approve:
 - the proposed transfer of appropriations;
 - the draft letter in ANNEX to that effect.
