	 Notifications and declarations

Document 7454/12 JAI 159 COPEN 51 sets out the notifications and declarations forwarded by Member States, to be made by the Council under Article 38 of the Agreement of 28 June 2006 between the European Union and the Republic of Iceland and the Kingdom of Norway on the surrender procedure between the Member States of the EU and Iceland and Norway.

Eight Member States have not yet conveyed their declarations and notifications. In view of the upcoming meeting of the Working Party on Cooperation in Criminal Matters (CCM) on 1 October 2012, these delegations are kindly invited to indicate:

- by which time they think they will be in a position to convey these notifications and declarations; and
- 2) to describe the state of play of the ongoing procedure (parliamentary/governmental) which has so far prevented these Member States from making these notifications/declarations.
