Statement by Denmark

Article 28 of the Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council of establishing minimum standards on the rights, support and protection of victims of crime is based on an understanding of the Protocol No 22 on the position of Denmark annexed to the Treaty on the European Union and to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union which Denmark does not agree with.

Denmark has noted the solution found in Article 28, which consists in specifying that the Directive amends Framework Decision 2001/220/JHA through replacing it, whereas the solution is without prejudice to the outcome of the ongoing discussion concerning future comparable situations.
