Commission - of the general budget for 2012

1. The Commission submitted to the Council proposal for a transfer of appropriations No DEC 33/2012.

The purpose of the proposal is to transfer an amount of EUR 3 258 308 in commitment appropriations from Article 05 05 02 (*Instrument for Pre-accession Assistance for Rural Development*) to Article 22 02 01 (*Transition and institution-building assistance to candidate countries*), as recorded in document 14298/12 FIN 702.

2. The transfer is being proposed to cover the continuation of the national programme supporting the agricultural and rural development sectors in Montenegro.
