1. The General Secretariat of the Council has been informed of the resignation of Mr Henning GRUB, as alternate member of the above Committee in the government representatives category (for Germany).
2. Under Article 27 of Regulation (EEC) No 1612/68 on freedom of movement for workers within the Community, members and alternate members are appointed by the Council.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1612/68 of 15 October 1968 on freedom of movement for workers within the Community¹, and in particular Articles 26 and 27 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) In its Decision of 4 October 2012², the Council appointed the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers for the period ending on 24 September 2014.
- (2) A seat as alternate member in the government representatives category has fallen vacant as a result of the resignation of Mr Henning GRUB.
- (3) The Government of Germany has submitted a nomination for the vacant seat,
