European Regional Development Fund Regulation

Chapter II

Indicators for ERDF support for the Investment for Growth and Jobs Goal

Article 6

Indicators for the Investment for Growth and Jobs Goal

Common <u>output</u> indicators, as set out in the Annex to this Regulation, <u>programme-specific result indicators and, where relevant, programme-specific output indicators</u> shall be used [...] in accordance with Article 24(3) <u>and Article 87(2)(b)(ii) and (iv)</u> of Regulation (EU) No [...]/2012 [CPR].

For <u>common and</u> programme-specific output indicators, baselines shall be set at zero [...]. Cumulative <u>quantified target values for these indicators</u> shall be fixed for 2022.

For programme-specific result indicators, which relate to investment priorities, baselines shall use the latest available data and targets shall be fixed for 2022. Targets may be expressed in quantitative or qualitative terms.

European Social Fund Regulation

Chapter I

General provisions

Article 5 Indicators

1. Common <u>output and result</u> indicators, as set out in the Annex to this Regulation and, <u>where</u> <u>relevant</u>, programme-specific indicators shall be used in accordance with Article 24(3) and 87(2)(b)(ii) <u>and (iv)</u> of Regulation (EU) No [...]/2012 [CPR]. [...]

For common and programme-specific output indicators <u>baselines shall be set at zero</u> [...]. Where relevant to the nature of the operations supported, cumulative quantified target values <u>for these indicators</u> shall be fixed for 2022. [...]

The data shall cover the <u>categories</u> of intervention in accordance with Article 87(2)(b)(vi) of Regulation (EU) No [...]/2012 [CPR] and the output and result indicators. By derogation from Article 44 (2) of Regulation (EU) No [...]/2012 [CPR], data transmitted for common and programme-specific indicators shall relate to values for partially or fully implemented operations.

Participants¹ refer to persons benefiting directly from an ESF investment and who can be identified and asked for their characteristics, and for whom specific expenditure is earmarked. Other beneficiaries should not be counted as participants.

- employed, including self-employed*

- above 54 years*

Their processing is necessary for compliance with the legal obligation to which the controller is subject (Article 7(c)). For the definition of controller, see Article 2 of that Directive.

Data reported under the indicators marked with ** are a special category of data according to Article 8 of Directive 95/46/EC. Subject to the provision of suitable safeguards, Member States may, for reasons of substantial public interest, lay down exemptions in addition to those laid down in Article 8(2) of that Directive, either by national law or by decision of the supervisory authority (Article 8(4) of that Directive).
