Item 5: WHO Framework Convention on Tobacco Control: draft protocol to eliminate illicit trade in tobacco products, Fifth session of the Conference of the Parties, Seoul, 12 November 2012

- Presentation by the Commission services

<u>The Working Party</u> heard a presentation by the Commission services of the state of play, in view of the above meeting of the Conference of the Parties and took note of delegations' comments.

Answering to a question by one delegation, <u>the Commission services</u> confirmed that, in case an EU statement would be delivered, it would explicitly refer to the EU and its Member States.

<u>The Chair</u> concluded that the coordinated position of the EU was to support the adoption of the Protocol as laid down in doc. FCTC/COP/5/6 and to oppose any possible attempt by other Parties to re-open the negotiations. The Chair informed delegations that the above meeting would be debriefed at a forthcoming meeting of the Working Party.
