Subject: COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 18.3.2016 amending Delegated Regulation (EU) 2015/2195 supplementing Regulation (EU) No 1304/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the European Social Fund, regarding the definition of standard scales of unit costs and lump sums for reimbursement of expenditure by the Commission to Member States

- Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

1. The Commission submitted the delegated act in subject¹ to the Council in accordance with Article 290 TFEU and Article 14(1) of Regulation (EU) No 1304/2013². The Commission having notified the delegated act on 18 March 2016, the Council may object to it until 18 May 2016.

2. The Working Party on Structural Measures examined the delegated act in question on 5 April 2016 and agreed, after an informal silence procedure, in which no objections were raised by delegations by the deadline of Tuesday, 12 April 2016, that there are no grounds for the Council to object to the delegated act.
 3. It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 24 of Regulation (EU) No 1304/2013³.
