Subject: Draft Council Decision appointing five members of the Court of Auditors
- Adoption

1. Pursuant to Article 286 (2) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, the Council, after consulting the European Parliament, shall adopt the list of Members of the Court of Auditors drawn up in accordance with the proposals made by each Member State, for a term of six years.
2. For the present partial renewal of the Court of Auditors, involving five members whose term of office expires on 6 May 2016, the Council consulted the European Parliament on 21 December 2015 and 9 February 2016 on the appointment of:
 - a) Mr Ladislav BALKO, proposed by the Government of the Slovak Republic, for a further term of office (13879/15 INST 400 CMPT 8);
 - b) Mr Mihails KOZLOVS, proposed by the Government of the Republic of Latvia, in place of Mr Igors LUDBORŽS (14446/15 INST 415 CMPT 11);
 - c) Mr Jan GREGOR, proposed by the Government of the Czech Republic, in place of Mr Jan KINŠT (14091/15 INST 406 CMPT 10);

- d) Mr Janusz WOJCIECHOWSKI, proposed by the Government of the Republic of Poland, in place of Mr Augustyn KUBIK (13904/1/15 REV1 INST 402 CMPT 9);
 - e) Mr Samo JEREB, proposed by the Government of the Republic of Slovenia, in place of Milan Martin CVIKL (5890/16 INST 38 CMPT 2).
3. The European Parliament delivered its opinion on these appointments on 13 April 2016.
 4. The Committee is therefore invited to suggest that the Council adopt the Decision appointing the above members of the Court of Auditors, as set out in 7266/16 INST 113 CMPT 3 as an item without discussion.
