Subject: Proposal for a Council Decision on the Union position to be adopted in the Joint Committee established by the Framework Agreement between the European Union and its Member States, on the one part, and the Republic of Korea, on the other part, in relation to the adoption of the rules of procedure of the Joint Committee, and the establishment of specialised working groups and the adoption of their terms of reference

1. On 17 March 2016, the Commission submitted to the Council a proposal for a Council Decision on the Union position to be adopted in the Joint Committee established by the Framework Agreement between the European Union and its Member States, on the one part, and the Republic of Korea, on the other part, in relation to the adoption of the rules of procedure of the Joint Committee, and the establishment of specialised working groups and the adoption of their terms of reference.
2. Following examination of the proposal by the Asia Oceania Working Party on 20 April, all delegations agreed to the draft Council Decision in question.

3. The Permanent Representatives Committee is accordingly invited to recommend that the Council at one of its upcoming meetings:
- adopts as an 'A' item the draft Council Decision on the Union position to be adopted in the Joint Committee established by the Framework Agreement between the European Union and its Member States, on the one part, and the Republic of Korea, on the other part, in relation to the adoption of the rules of procedure of the Joint Committee, and the establishment of specialised working groups and the adoption of their terms of reference, as set out after finalisation by the Legal/Linguistic experts in document 8184/16.
